The exhibit should have a title, some text on each page to help tell the story or explain the philatelic material being shown. Depth of research and quality/selection of material is important. Creativity is encouraged – a unique idea, first versus third person, humor, presentation (mounting layout, paper, fonts), etc. Have fun with your stamps!
